ATTENDANCE AT THE HISTORIC CHATHAM DOCKYARD MODEL RAILWAY SHOW

Over the weekend of 20 & 21 July the group attended the Chatham and District Model Railway Club (C&DMRC) event within the historic Chatham Dockyard. The Garden of England Railway(GER) layout along with the pop up banners and information table were set up on the afternoon of Friday 19th July 2024.



There were over 100 layouts, displays, demonstrators and trade outlets present at this event. This was the first C&DMRC event for six year and their first at the historic Dockyard in twelve years. The Saturday was by far the busier day with visitors including some celebrities who are known for their enjoyment of model railways and came and looked at the GER. There has been a lot of interest online with positive comments regarding the event. The GER looked at home in the vast expanse of the covered slip also being located just inside the entrance on the right.



Due to the dockyard still being an active industrial site, there was a requirement for the members of the group who helped to set up and run the GER layout to wear yellow high visibility vest/jacket when walking around the slip and wider dockyard prior to the event opening, they were also required when in areas away from the public, hence why in some of the images some members are still wearing them. These vests belong to the group and have for future events when there is the requirement.

Planning had already begun by the C&DMRC before the event this year for the 2025 event which will be over the weekend 19 & 20 July 2025. The Kent Group of the Society has already been approached to attend.
