### KENT GROUP AUTUMN INDOOR RUNNING EVENT - SATURDAY 19 OCTOBER 2024

The Group held its Autumn Indoor running event on Saturday 19 October 2024 at Christ Church & Hall, Luton, Chatham ME4 5BT. Doors opened to the public slightly early as there were people turning up early and had travelled on local buses. This event was free for members of the group and wider society; however, donations are always welcome.

This was the largest venue the group has hired and display space was over two floors. We had both Kent Garden Railways (KGR) and Chalk Garden Rail as the Traders at the event along with Off\_The\_Rails who we first met at the K&ESR 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Gala weekend who sells printed items.

The total of Non-members attending this event were not as many as expected, but this was possibly due to two other model railway shows taking place on the same day not too far away. Having non-members attend helps finance the event paying for the venue hire etc.

Also Rainbow Rock layout attended and looked good in the hall, sadly it cannot attend our winter indoor meet & AGM at Teynham on Sunday 26 January 2025, however the LB&L line will be there so members attending can see and enquire how it works.

Many of you would not know that the group had been close to being wound up due to the lack of support in the area of positions on the committee. The group after covid lost a number of good working committee members and this being people moving home (Martin Piper) and some others resigning after years of hard work that left us in a position that we would not be able to continue as a functioning group.

The good news was at the 2023 AGM a number of people came forward and this kept the group alive and with that we were also able to recruit a number of new members that came forward to make up a full committee by the middle of 2024. In regards to this I would like to thank all the committee members standing on the Kent G Scale committee for all the hard work that has been carried out this year in the running, promotion of our group and hobby.

### Members' Sales Stand - Rules and Instructions

- 1. Selling items on the Members' Sales stand is a service provided only to G Scale Members. Members may be asked to produce membership cards when booking items in.
- 2. The Members' Sales stand is for private sales only, and not for use by traders.
- 3. Items will be accepted for sale at the discretion of the stand manager. Bulky, low value items, such as spare parts or magazines may only be accepted once there is more room on the stand or may be placed at the back.
- 4. The stewards on the stand will take every reasonable care, but all items are displayed, handled and offered for sale at the owner's risk.
- 5. It is the vendor's responsibility to double check that each item for sale has a label securely attached, showing the name, item number and the price. A variety of label types are available on the stand.
- 6. Items for sale must be listed on this form, using a separate line for each lot, e.g. if you are selling five identical items you should specify each item separately, unless you are selling them as a set of five when they should be listed as a single item.
- 7. It is the seller's responsibility to identify any items that are incomplete, damaged or not in running order.
- 8. Please complete columns 1 and 3 overleaf for each lot. Please do not enter anything into the shaded columns overleaf as these are for administrative use.
- 9. 10% of the sale price of all items sold by the member will be taken as commission and donated to the Local Area Group. Commission will be deducted before payment is made to the vendor.
- 10. Buyers may pay by cash or credit/debit card. Cheque payments will only accepted if the vendor so indicates on the front of the form. Where payments are made by card the vendor may not receive payment of their sales proceeds until after the event, such payment being made by Cheque from the Group account or by bank transfer if the vendor is content to provide their bank details.
- 11. Sale proceeds in cash must be collected at the latest by 4pm together with any unsold

items. Any uncollected items may be disposed of for the benefit of the G Scale Local Area Group.

12. Completion of the form overleaf and offering the goods for sale is taken as acceptance of the above conditions.
