## <u>KENT GROUP ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING –</u> SUNDAY 26 JANUARY 2025

The Group held its Annual General Meeting during the Winter Indoor meet at Teynham Village Hall. A good turnout with Thirteen members in attendance. John Morgan who had been on the Committee for 10 years didn't stand for re-election. A vote of thanks was voted on and unanimously passed. He along with Andrew Lloyd and Roger Alan were given Honory member status for service to the group.

Due to the introduction of some bank charges the treasurer is to look at other banks to see what options are available. Enquiries will be made with other groups similar to ours to ascertain if their banks are introducing similar charges.

Alex Evans-Addy announced he was prepared to stand for election as the Groups Secretary, his nomination was formally proposed, seconded and was voted upon which was unanimously passed & carried.

During the AGM it was suggested about connecting with younger members of society by utilizing social media platforms such as TikTok. This is to be looked at and trials undertaken.

Draft minutes of the AGM will be published on the website and voted upon at the AGM which is likely to be held at Teynham Village Hall on Sunday 25 January 2026 at the groups next Winter indoor meet.

## **KENT GROUP WINTER INDOOR RUNNING EVENT – SUNDAY 26 JANUARY 2025**

The Group held its Winter Indoor Meet at Teynham Village Hall on Sunday 26 January 2025. This was the first event of the Group has attended and ran in 2025. Numbers of those attending were on par with last year despite a change of advertising approach, the day started off well with visitors, but as the weather front of storm Herminia approached the weather outside the hall turned quite inclement and the numbers of people venturing out reduced quite considerably. Total society members attending including those running the event was Thirty-Three (33). Non-members attending were Thirty-Two (32) Adults and eight (8) children. This year within the hall we had the Garden of England Railway in the middle of the hall similar to recent years. Chris Worby attended with his Sagor variant of the Crib Lane layout which is the first time this has attended for several years but with some changes to its previous incarnation. The Lehmann(LGB), Bachmann & Lego(LB&L) Line was set at the far end of the hall and Stuart Guy was at the buffet end with his turning triangle display. This was beside a television showing short film footage and photographs of members gardens within Kent. There was a members second hand stall present which did good trade and was popular. Nick and Peter were in attendance across the hall with Chalk Garden Rail as the sole trader. Many thanks to those bringing their layouts, displays and stalls for which the committee is very much appreciated and to those keeping us all fed and watered with the refreshments. Thanks also go to those who helped with the setting up, during the day or the take down at the end of the show. We covered our costs and have been able to add to the bank account. Hopfield 16mm society layout has already been confirmed to attend the Teynham event in 2026 which marks the start of our groups 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary year and will be on Sunday 25 January 2026 10:30AM - 4:00PM.
